Akita International University Overview

- Founded: 2004
- Student Body: 804 (Appr. 200 International Students) *Fall 2019
 - Student Exchange: Appr. 190 Outbound/290 Inbound per year
- Full-time Faculty: 58 (53% International)
 - 14:1 Student/Faculty ratio
 - Average 18 students/class
- 1 Faculty: International Liberal Arts
 - Global Business, Global Studies, Global Connectivity (2021)
 - Japan Studies Program, Japanese Language Program



Exchange Program Overview

- One-Year Study Abroad Required for Graduation
- 200 Partners in 50 Countries
 - 90%+ Active Exchange
- Tuition-Waiver Exchange
- Take courses in major taught in English (30 credits/year)
 - Language study abroad
- In general, 1-2 students per university at a time

- 120+ students sent / 180+ students received
 - Appr. 10 20 students sent / 20-30 students received per year
 - #2-#4 annually in terms in inbound/outbound student numbers
- 3 Distinct Types of Partners
 - Business Schools (5)
 - Social Sciences/Political Science (4)
 - Language Study Abroad (1)
